RR	<p>Mick Richings The Waste Recycling Centre, Allerton <i>Transport: own car, with lift sharing encouraged</i> Important information: <i>The site tour involves a walk of about 1 km round trip. You will need to climb 30 metal steps. Some groups can access the control room. There is a lift, but in an emergency, you must use the stairs. There are 8 flights of stairs to descend. Access to the control room depends on availability that day. It's essential to wear suitable footwear and clothing for an industrial site visit. Wear thick-soled shoes with no open toes. This keeps your feet completely covered—no bare skin or high heels. You must cover your legs. Trousers are best, but leggings or similar are fine too. We will not allow anyone dressed unsuitably on the site tour. Please be aware the site tour can leave a lingering smell on clothing.</i></p> <p><i>Due to the risk of infection, if you have an immune-suppressed disease, have had an organ transplant recently, or are on chemotherapy, we do not recommend joining the onsite tour.</i></p>
